ARTIST APPLICATION

The Tychman Shapiro Gallery is approximately 850 square feet. The gallery floor is carpeted and there is a new lighting system in place that caters to both 2 and 3 dimensional works. Exhibitions are typically six weeks in length with a 10 day strike/installation period between. The gallery assumes responsibility for insurance of the work while on exhibit in the Gallery. Exhibitions must be approved for display by the Tychman Shapiro Gallery Director and Gallery Committee. The Tychman Shapiro Gallery exhibits include installation, postcards, postage, PR, and an artist's reception. To apply, please submit an Artist Application and an Exhibition Proposal. Proposals are accepted throughout the year.

Exhibition Proposal

Please fill out and return the Exhibition Form with your application.

Resume

The artist resume must include name, address, and phone number. If this is a collaboration or group proposal, include resumes of all involved parties, noting the role of each person's involvement in this show. No more than 2 pages per person.

Artist Statement

Artist Statement must correlate with proposed work.

Work Samples and List of Works

The following are acceptable work sample formats; you may submit no more than two of the following (please do not send originals):

- 15-20 35mm slides or photographs (label each slide or photo with your name, title, medium, year, and dimensions)
- Audio or Video (DVD or audio CDs, ten-minute maximum, cued to starting point, label with your name, title of work, length and year)
- CD (label with your name, title of work, media)

Please include a numbered List of Works with title, medium, year and dimensions.

Return of Work Samples

If you want your work returned by mail, please provide a self-addressed, stamped envelope. You may also pick up work samples at the Sabes JCC when notified by the Gallery Director. If your work is accepted, your work samples become the property of the Tychman Shapiro Gallery.
