OUR COMMUNITY GARDEN brings the community together to grow organic food, build relationships, and share in the act of “Tikkun Olam” – repairing the world.

Nearly 3,000 square feet, the garden features twenty kinds of fruits and vegetables including zucchini, peas, strawberries, tomatoes, radishes – plus herbs and flowers.

What makes our garden special is that it is designed so that everyone can enjoy and participate - no matter what their age, interests or abilities. The garden was designed with raised beds and wide aisles so people who require walkers, wheelchairs, or other devices can easily move in and around the garden for full enjoyment.

A large portion of the food from the garden is being donated to local food shelves to provide need-based individuals and families with fresh organic produce. The produce will also be enjoyed by the community during JCC events and throughout the Camp Olami season where children will be able to taste and cook their harvest.
