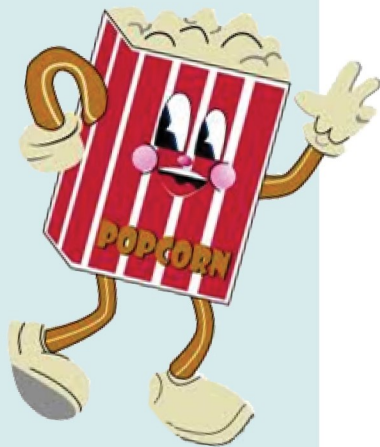

February 5 – “Enemy at the Gates”

(Rated R, Runtime: 131 mins; Drama, History, War)
In World War II, the fall of Stalingrad will mean the collapse of the whole country. The Germans and Russians are fighting over every block, leaving only ruins behind. The Russian sniper Vassili Zaitsev stalks the Germans, taking them out one by one, thus hurting the morale of the German troops. He and Political Officer Danilov fall in love with the same female soldier and a German sniper is on his tail.

February 12 – “A River Runs Through It”

(Rated PG, Runtime: 124 mins; Drama)
The Maclean brothers, Paul and Norman, live a relatively idyllic life in rural Montana, spending much of their time fly fishing. The sons of a minister, the boys eventually part company when Norman moves east to attend college, leaving his rebellious brother to find trouble back home. When Norman finally returns, the siblings resume their fishing outings, and assess both where they’ve been and where they are going.
